# 1. Islamic Etiquette and Behavior

- Students are expected to uphold Islamic manners at all times showing respect to teachers, peers, and themselves.
- The use of foul language, disrespect, or dishonesty is not tolerated.
- Kindness, honesty, patience, and humility are core values.
- Conflict must be addressed through respectful dialogue and staff guidance.

### 2. Dress Code

More than just creating uniformity among students, the dress code is meant to instill God-consciousness in both boys and girls- dressing according to the way Allah SWT is pleased with. As part of their Islamic Studies curriculum, and daily practice of salah, students will understand the why behind hijab and modesty.

- Students must adhere to Islamic guidelines:
  - Girls: Green shirt, beige Jumper and beige flare leggings or pants. Girls are expected to wear the white Hijab starting in 4th grade.
- Boys: Green shirt, beige pants.

Clothes must be clean, respectful, and free of inappropriate images or words. Size and fit must be appropriate for salah prayer.

### 3. Salah

- Daily Dhuhr prayer will be held and students are expected to participate respectfully.
- Students must attend morning adhkar(Assembly) as part of the school culture.

# 4. Attendance & Punctuality

- Students must attend regularly and arrive on time.
- Repeated unexcused absences or tardiness may result in a parent meeting and possible action.
- Parents must notify the school for any absence due to illness or family matters.

# 5. Academics & Responsibility

- Students must complete all assignments and projects with excellence.
- Cheating, plagiarism, and dishonesty in schoolwork is not allowed.
- Students are expected to bring necessary materials and be prepared to learn.

# 6. Technology and Devices

- Personal devices (phones, tablets) are not allowed during school hours unless approved by staff.
- Internet use must be for educational purposes only and under supervision.
- Inappropriate use of technology will result in confiscation and parental notification.

# 7. Cleanliness & Care for the school space

- Students must keep their personal space and classroom areas clean and tidy.
- Respect for school property and others' belongings is mandatory.
- Wudu and cleanliness habits are encouraged and taught.

# 9. Discipline and Growth

- Discipline will be rooted in Islamic tarbiyah, not punishment.
- First offenses will involve verbal reminders and reflection opportunities.
- Repeated concerns may involve written documentation, parent meetings, or temporary suspension if needed.
